- 1. Call to Order:** The Conservation Commission was called to order by Chairman Edward Fisher at the Municipal Building at 4:40 p.m.

Attendance: Present were chairman Edward Fisher, Charles Brock, Steve Cartwright, Jack Farlow, Claire Bowley, Medomak Valley Land Trust executive director Liz Petruska, local resident George Keyes, Recreation Director Kyle Santheson, Selectman Ted Wooster.

- 2. Minutes** of the previous meeting were approved 4-0.
- 3. Liz Petruska** presented an update on the Quarry Hill management plan and hoped-for grants, indicating that work will begin with funds on hand. She will be meeting with consultants Barrie Brusilla and Janet McMahon.
- 4. Various projects** that the Conservation Commission could take on were discussed, including creating a picnic area at an improved site on town land at Dutch Neck, and a Medomak River walking trail through at least part of the village. Kyle Santheson overheard the discussion from his office and joined the meeting, saying he would like to see a walking/exercise trail around the new town ball fields near Miller School. The Commission voted unanimously in favor of such a project, which is expected to involve some labor but cost very little to create.
- 5. Adjourn by 5:30 p.m.** - The Commission voted 4-0 to adjourn. The next meeting will be Monday, July 5, 2010, at 4:30 p.m. at the town office.
