Attendance: Present were Claire Bowley, Jack Farlow, and Chairman George Keyes; and Planning & Development Director Bill Najpauer and Selectman Ted Wooster

Call to Order: The Conservation Commission was called to order by Chairman George Keyes at the Municipal Building at 5:45 p.m.

1. **Minutes** of the April 3rd meeting were approved.

2. **Town**

- As planned, George Keyes talked at length with land owner Staples, who seems quite willing to allow use of the cleared trail (barring any actions by users).
- **George** is planning to talk with Pat Magee, after she arrives in Waldoboro for the summer.
- **Ted Wooster** will talk with Winchenbach after Magee has been contacted.
- Following the above, this Committee will decide “where to from here”

3. **Dutch Neck Marine Park.**

- The first picnic table has been received. George Keyes will endeavor to talk with John Daigle this coming week about details of its placement (near the south end of the large parking area) and of its installation. At the same time we need to learn more about the Town’s proposed plans for an expanded parking lot(s), and to get John’s input on details for two-car road-side parking at the new trailheads (**George**).
- **George** and **Claire** will contact the Shellfish Commission about an event publicizing both the Shellfish Commission and the Conservation Commission at the Marine Park this summer.
- Detailed plans for obtaining and affixing a suitable table placque (**Claire**)

4. **Quarry Hill**

- The Town is working out a 5-year lease for the “corn field” @ \$400/year with Bob Spear (“the best-educated farmer in Maine” and the former head of the Maine Department of Education(?)).

5. **Quarry Hill Time Records** Be sure to fill out your logs, as we can use hours as well as dollars for grant matching purposes!
6. **Medomak Valley High School's "Heirloom Seed Program"** (**George** will find out more and report back to us)


Adjournment at 6:45 p.m., approved unanimously.
