Conservation Commission Meeting Minutes

Attendance: Present were Claire Bowley, Jack Farlow, and Chairman George Keyes; and Planning & Development Director Bill Najpauer

Call to Order: The Conservation Commission was called to order by Chairman George Keyes at the Municipal Building at 5:35 p.m.

1. **Minutes** of the June 5th meeting were approved.

2. **Quarry Hill**

- **Bill Najpauer** reported that, since Janet MacMahon and Barrie Brusilla each donated eight professional hours, and these having been combined with Conservation Commission time, the requirement for the value of the Town match had been met for the Project Canopy Grant.
- **George Keyes** is presently waiting for Bill Najpauer to have time for them both to meet with Mr. MacDonald about in-holder issues. Subsequently, all three would meet for a similar discussion with Mr. Dickey. Additional discussion items would include locating a nice trail close to his property to provide access to the old quarries and ravine behind and also the issues relating to an access point for selectively cutting (and improving) a woodlot.

3. **Dutch Neck Marine Park.**

- **George Keyes** reports the Town has done nothing following his discussion with John Daigle's designee:
 1. No further action on the present and future parking lots has been visible
 2. The picnic table has not been installed
 3. No trash has been removed from the trash barrels
- **Town Manager John Spear** needs to discuss priorities with John Daigle
- **Jack Farlow** reports that Ed Fisher has not cut the new trail to the little point close to the launch ramp, and Ed doesn't plan to in the future. Perhaps Jack and George can find time to do it this fall.

4. **Possible Volunteers** could include the Boy Scouts and High School Community Action Volunteers
